

## Woodlawn Care Center Outdoor Visitation Plan -- Quick Reference Guide

Visitors will...	Staff will...	Residents will...
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Come by appointment only</li> <li>● Make appointments at least 24 hours in advance</li> <li>● Pre-screen while making an appointment</li> <li>● Call upon arrival if possible</li> <li>● Answer screening questions and have their temperature taken upon arrival</li> <li>● Be limited to only 2 visitors during a visit</li> <li>● Be at least 12 years or older</li> <li>● Wear cloth or surgical masks covering nose and mouth at all times</li> <li>● Avoid touching their face, nose, eyes, or mask</li> <li>● Practice hand hygiene at the start of the visit, any time they touch their face/mask, and upon completion of the visit</li> <li>● Remain 6 feet apart from staff and residents</li> <li>● Avoid physical contact with other visitors, staff, and residents</li> <li>● Remain in the designated visitation area</li> <li>● Visit no more than two times per week</li> <li>● Limit their visit to 45 minutes or less</li> <li>● Monitor for symptoms for 48 hours after visit and notify WLCC if symptoms present themselves</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Assist visitors in scheduling appointments</li> <li>● Screen visitors and residents, as well as check temperatures, prior to the visit</li> <li>● Safely transport residents in and out of the building for visits</li> <li>● Wear surgical masks covering nose and mouth at all times</li> <li>● Wear face shields at all times</li> <li>● Remain close enough to ensure compliance with visitation policy but also far enough to allow for privacy between the resident and the visitors</li> <li>● Remain 6 feet from visitors and 6 feet from residents when possible</li> <li>● Carry alcohol based hand sanitizer and ensure hand hygiene policies are followed</li> <li>● Practice hand hygiene at the start of the visit, any time they touch their face/mask, and upon completion of the visit</li> <li>● Clean and disinfect all surfaces touched by visitors and residents after each visit</li> <li>● Remind visitors to monitor themselves for symptoms 48 hours after visit</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Answer screening questions and have their temperature taken prior to leaving the building</li> <li>● Wear surgical masks covering nose and mouth at all times</li> <li>● Avoid touching their face, nose, eyes, or mask</li> <li>● Practice hand hygiene at the start of the visit, any time they touch their face/mask, and upon completion of the visit</li> <li>● Remain 6 feet away from visitors and 6 feet from staff when possible</li> <li>● Remain in the designated visitation area</li> </ul>
